EUGENE, Ore.—Mark Packer, MD, an ophthalmologist at the Oregon Eye Institute, has been appointed Clinical Associate Professor in the Department of Ophthalmology at the School of Medicine, at Oregon Health & Science University.

A *cum laude* graduate of Harvard University, **Dr. Packer** is a partner in Drs. Fine, Hoffman and Packer, LLC, Ophthalmologists in Eugene, Oregon. He earned his medical degree from the University of California at Davis, received his training in ophthalmology at Boston University Medical School and was certified by the American Board of Ophthalmology in 1997. He also was an Assistant Clinical Professor of Surgery at East Carolina University from 1995 until 2000.

Dr. Packer specializes in cataract, refractive and glaucoma surgery. His clinical research focuses on new technology, including intraocular lenses, corneal refractive surgery and glaucoma devices. Dr. Packer has authored or coauthored more than 60 journal articles and textbook chapters, delivered over 100 presentations at scientific meetings and performed live surgery on four continents.

As Clinical Associate Professor Dr. Packer will continue to attend and instruct resident surgery at the Veterans Affairs Medical Center in Portland.
